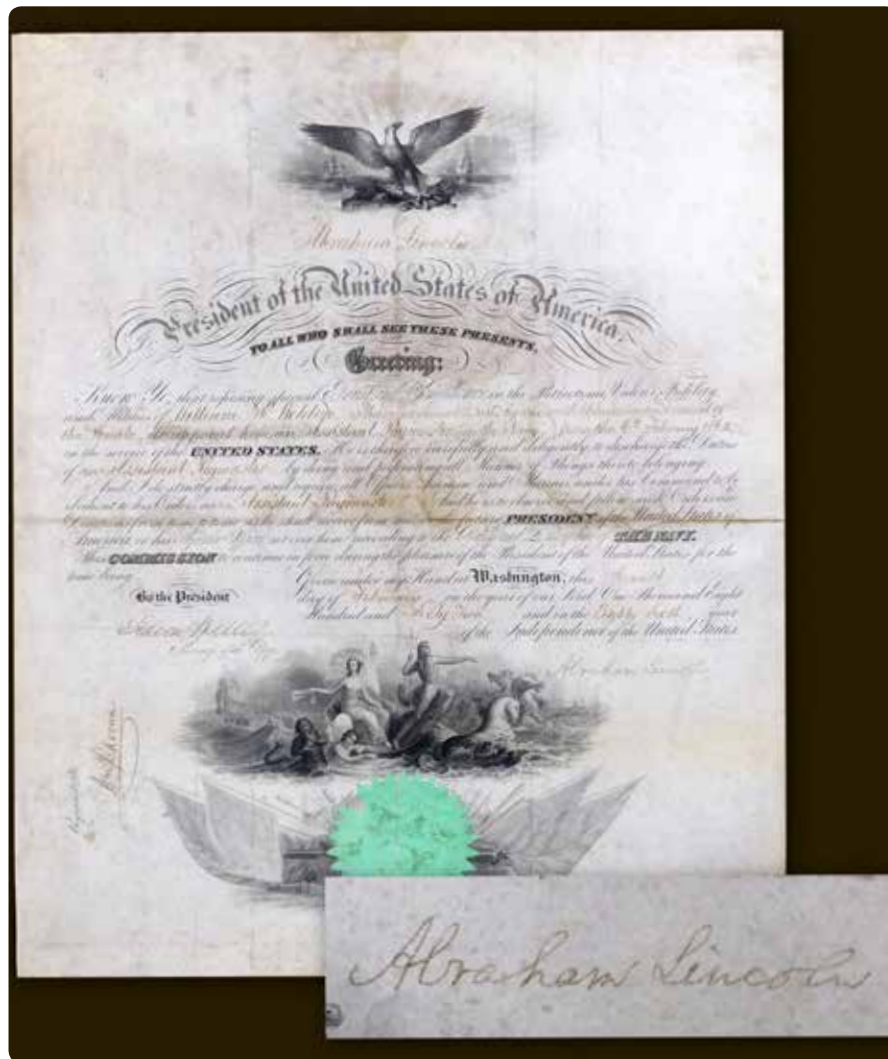

1 GEORGE WASHINGTON (1732-1799) & THOMAS JEFFERSON (1743-1826) DOCUMENT SIGNED AS PRESIDENT & SECRETARY OF STATE--EXCEEDINGLY RARE THREE LANGUAGE SHIP'S PASSPORT

Washington: first President, Commander-in-Chief Continental Army; Jefferson: third President, SIGNER DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE, first Secretary of State. Exceedingly RARE DS "Go: Washington" & "Th: Jefferson", 12.75x16, June 1793 three language Ship's Passport issued to Master "Thomas Horton...commander of the Schooner Robin...port of Philadelphia bound for Hispaniola and laden with Provisions", Washington's signature as large, dark & bold as we've seen, Jefferson's large, dark & bold, with some see-through, toning, some paper loss with professional archival restoration, artfully custom framed & matted with color portraits overall size 41.5x20. Please note, due to size & weight shipping will not be inexpensive, however this important, valued addition to any Presidential collection is well worth it

Second President, SIGNER DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE. RARE manuscript DS "John Adams", 7.5x2.5, Jan 16 1815, Quincy, MA., elegantly penned in the hand of his wife, Abigail Adams, receipt "...for the rent of Babel pasture for the year 1814 on the Twentieth November.", John's signature & Abigail's penning both dark, bold & pristine, small area of light staining top left edge, handsomely custom framed & matted with portrait overall size 10x13

3 ABRAHAM LINCOLN (1809-1865) WAR DATED AUTOGRAPH ENDORSEMENT SIGNED AS PRESIDENT--TO "THE SECRETARY OF WAR"

16th President, led country through Civil War, assassinated. WAR DATED, Jan 1 1863, AES, in full: "Respectfully submitted to the Secretary of War. A. Lincoln, Jan. 5, 1863", 7.75x9.75, penned by Lincoln on the blank reverse of the second page of a handwritten letter addressed to Lincoln by Major General Robert Schenck, in part: "I dislike to ask anything for one of my own family, but I have a nephew now in the Eleventh Reg't Iowa Volunteer Infantry, in Genl. Grant's army, whom I earnestly recommend to you for appointment to a Second Lieutenantcy to fill any vacancy in one of the new Regiments of the United States Army. He is a brave gallant and promising young soldier."

American transportation pioneers, founded American Express and Wells, Fargo

& Co to provide safe, swift transcontinental express service. Colorful American Express Co stock certificate with grand lithography signed "Henry Wells" as President & "Wm G. Fargo" as Secretary, 12x8, May 1 1866, also signed by Alex Holland as Treasurer, usual cancellation cuts slightly affect both signatures, artfully custom matted with vintage, original Wells, Fargo & Co envelope & plaque overall size 16.75x26. Of historical note, American Express was started in 1850 as an express mail business in Buffalo, New York, two years later Wells & Fargo also started Wells Fargo & Co. when some American Express directors objected to their proposal that American Express extend its operations to California

American professional boxer, former World Heavyweight Champion, best known as the man who defeated the great John L. Sullivan, faced the best competition his era had to offer; squaring off with a total of 9 fighters who would later be enshrined alongside him in the International Boxing Hall of Fame. Extremely RARE 1925 gold-embossed, cloth-bound First Edition hardcover book "The Roar of the Crowd" written by Corbett signed, inscribed & dated on first free page "To My friend Herbert Saskett With warmest regards Jas J Corbett Bayside, N.Y. Sept 15/25", G.P. Putnam's Sons New York & London The Knickerbocker Press 1925, accompanied by certification from JSA. Of historical note, though later editions of "The Roar of the Crowd" signed by Corbett do appear on the marketplace from time to time, signed First Editions are Extremely RARE, our first to auction

American poet, novelist, known as the King of Greenwich Village Bohemians, his writing brought him international fame during the Jazz age of the 1920s, murdered, along with his wife, at age 62 by a 25 year old dishwasher who Bodenheim befriended on the streets of Greenwich Village. Exceedingly RARE ALS "Maxwell Bodenheim", 5.25x7, no date, filled with Bodenheim's fantastic musings, in part: "Freedom is only the lowest possible degree of slavery, and yet the struggle for it brings delicately questioning peace to the center of ones being..."

RARE ALS WITH GRAND CONTENT & CONNECTION

American inventor, manufacturer, invention of cotton gin revolutionized cotton industry, established first factory to assemble muskets with interchangeable parts, marking advent of modern mass production. Exceedingly RARE ALS "E. Whitney", 7.75x8, Oct 5 1821 offering grand connection & content, to Oliver Wolcott, Jr., Governor of Connecticut, in part: "The Cattle Show at this place will be had on the 9th & 10th inst - I will be at Litchfield on the evening of Monday the 15th (if that day is fair, if not on the next fair day)...", haloing to ink in a few lines, handsomely framed & matted with engraved portrait, overall size of 20.5x14.5. Of historical note, Whitney established his cotton gin factory in New Haven & as a member of the New Haven Agricultural Society helped establish the annual county fair around 1810, officially called the New Haven Agricultural Fair and Cattle Show, one of the earliest such fairs in America. Attractively priced, autographic material from Whitney extremely RARE listing in Sanders just under \$3,000. This letter_s connection & content makes it especially desirable

Cuban revolutionary, national leader, governed the Republic of Cuba as Prime Minister from 1959 to 1976 & as President from 1976 to 2008, under his administration Cuba became a one-party socialist state; industry & businesses were nationalized, state socialist reforms were implemented throughout society. Exceedingly RARE soft-cover book "La Aurora De Los Heroes" by Juan Almeida Bosque signed "Fidel Castro" on inside front cover, as large, dark, bold & pristine a Castro signature as we've seen, with Castro adding lengthy inscription & notation to the author, also dated by Castro "Mayo de 1999", wear to book, some pages loose, portion of title page torn off, accompanied by full letter certification from PSA/DNA

Winston Link entitled "Train No. 17, The Birmingham Special, Gets a Highball" (Rural Retreat, Virginia), 15.5x19.25, with Link's signature, print date, negative notation NW 1635 & additional printing notations, in pencil & his copyright hand stamp, also with the negative notation, in pencil, on verso, 1957, printed 1991, a crisp, strong impression

British intelligence officer, author, noted for spy novels featuring James Bond. RARE, choice TLS "Yours sincerely Ian Fleming", 8x10, Dec 21 1950 on embossed Kemsley House stationery to Clarence Winchester, Editor at Dropmore Press, in part: "Thank you very much indeed for the copy of 'Eton Medley.' It was a very kind thought, and I had not seen it before....I have told the Chairman that you will be letting him have a memorandum of the present position and a draft letter to the Hon. David Smith...", with Fleming handwriting "Dear Mr Winchester," & "yours sincerely" Of historical note, around 1950 Fleming joined Dropmore Press as a director, "Eton Medley" was B.J.W. Hill's book about Eton College, from which, as a youth, Fleming was expelled - a piece of his own history that was added to the dossier of his most famous literary character, James Bond

British archaeologist, Egyptologist whose discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun in Egypt's "Valley of the Kings" proved to be one of the singular events in the history of

archaeology. Exceedingly RARE manuscript DS in Arabic, signed "Howard Carter", 6.75x8.25, May 2 1903 to the director of the General Archaeology Directorate, in part: "...an inspection has been conducted of the building constructed by the father of Hamid Effendi Abdulmunim at the archaeological site on the island Aswan...150 Egyptian pounds estimated for the building is a vey appropriate and reasonable value...", ink notations at bottom in another hand, two punch holes left edge, staple holes top margin. Of historical note, in 1903 Carter transferred to the Inspectorate of Lower and Middle Egypt, excavating at Aswan with the likes of Lady William Cecil Amherst
